

## CAOHC- Approved Occupational Hearing Conservationist Recertification Course

Online: Nov 14

Onsite: Davenport, IA Nov 15 or Altoona, IA Nov 16

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:** This 8 hour course is designed to provide a review of the basic components of hearing conservation in industrial settings and prepare participants to continue performing hearing testing and otherwise support their hearing conservation programs.

This hybrid course provides online instruction via Zoom, and a face-to-face day of hands-on, practical training. At the conclusion of the hands-on day, students will take the standardized CAOHC recertification exam online.

### OBJECTIVES

Upon course completion, participants will be able to:

1. Describe the responsibilities and scope of practice of Occupational Hearing Conservationists.
2. Identify parts of audiometric equipment, maintenance, calibration requirements, and potential issues with equipment or testing environment.
3. Administer pure tone air conduction audiometric tests, compliant with federal standards.
4. Manage special issues in hearing conservation.
5. Identify types and causes of hearing loss, and bases for appropriate review and referral.
6. Discuss federal and state regulations regarding hearing conservation.
7. Identify hearing protection device types, and describe purposes, fitting, maintenance, and efficacy.
8. Discuss requirements for hearing conservation education, and ways of improving employee motivation.
9. Identify necessary record-keeping for compliance with regulations and for best practice.

### **About the Exam:**

The CAOHC online certification exam will be administered at the end of the class. **Students will be responsible for providing their own laptop/tablet to access the exam.** The examination is a standardized test produced and graded by CAOHC, consistent with ANSI and ISO standards. Results are typically provided the same day. In the event that a student does not pass the initial exam, there is a retest option available. The class registration includes the CAOHC certification and exam fee; if a retest is needed, the first retest fee is waived. There is a \$75 fee for a second retest.

### **Cancellations:**

In the event that a student has been tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19, is experiencing symptoms, or is otherwise concerned about attending for COVID-19 related reasons, an alternate date for completion of the face-to-face portion will be scheduled, or a full refund will be provided.

Registrations which are cancelled for other reasons by Nov 4 will be refunded in full minus \$50 and any course materials which may have been shipped; after that point, cancellations will be refunded 75% through Nov 11. No refund will be made after the course has commenced, except in case of emergency. Please contact the course director in that event.

### **COVID-19 Measures:**

The face-to-face day will be capped at 8 attendees per location per day. If there is sufficient interest, additional face-to-face days and locations will be scheduled.

-Students will observe physical distancing as well as possible during all parts of the practicum.

-Masks may be required, depending upon current recommendations, community transmission rates, etc.

**Please remember to bring your own mask.** KN95s and N95s may also be available.

-Sanitizing wipes for the audiometers and other equipment will be provided.

-Hand sanitizer will be provided.

**-If you are experiencing symptoms, have had an exposure, or have tested positive,** please contact the Course Director to discuss scheduling an alternate date.
